Position: Music Minister (Part-Time)

Principal Function:

The Music Minister is responsible to the pastor for the music ministry of the church.

Qualifications:

- 1. A clear testimony of faith in Jesus Christ and a personal relationship with Him.
- 2. Background in music and/or leading music worship services.
- 3. Flexible music styles (traditional and contemporary).
- 4. Knowledge of relevant technology.
- 5. Audio/video system proficiency.
- 6. Affirm belief and witness to the Baptist Faith and Message 2000 and to the Oak Grove Baptist Church Covenant and By-laws and Statement of Faith and Practice.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Plan weekly worship services in coordination with the pastor.
- 2. Participate in weekly staff meetings with pastor and other applicable staff members.
- 3. Direct congregational singing at all regularly scheduled worship services, which includes Sunday morning and evening and Wednesday evening, with the ability to lead both contemporary and traditional.
- 4. Direct the planning, organizing, and evaluation of a comprehensive music program, including adult and youth choirs, soloists, worship teams/ensembles, and/or instrumental ensembles.
- 5. Ensure the music and/or musical production is based upon true Bible doctrine.
- 6. Work with, and give directions to, the church pianist and/or accompanists in arranging and providing music for worship.
- 7. In addition to the regular worship services, work with the pastor on planning and holding special worship services/events/ ministries and other church-related activities including 5th Sunday Singing, Christmas Eve Service, Christmas and Easter cantatas, etc.
- 8. Prepare and administer an annual music budget.
- 9. Monitor the purchase, maintenance, and replacement of all music-related equipment, supplies and instruments in accordance with procedural approval and budgetary means.
- 10. Coordinate the music program with the annual church calendar.
- 11. Prepare music worship service (congregational hymns and specials) at least two (2) weeks in advance.
- 12. Download two (2) weeks in advance the worship music lyrics each week to the computer for tv monitor display during services.

- 13. During any absence of the Music Minister or the accompanist (pianist), arrange a replacement, if possible.
- 14. Actively participate in (along with family), and support, the events and programs of the church, including outreach efforts and other events.
- 15. Other duties as assigned by the pastor.
